## VISIT OF THE DIRECTOR OF ISEM TO THE WORLD MARITIME UNIVERSITY (WMU) IN MALMO – SWEDEN

The Director of the Higher Institute for Maritime Studies, Mr. **Mohamed BRIOUIG**, took part in the graduation ceremony of the World Maritime University (**WMU**) class of 2022, held on **Monday, October 31, 2022** in Malmö, Sweden.

The Class of 2022 includes 276 graduates from 70 countries, and sets a record of 94 women graduates. This Class now joins the global network of WMU alumni who are leaders in the maritime and ocean sectors, working towards a sustainable future. Among the graduates, Miss Latifa OUMOUZOUNE, Senior Engineer and Head of department at ISEM, who got her Master's degree in "Maritime Education and Training".

This training and development of ISEM's staff is a strategic objective of ISEM's development strategy. It is also part of the implementation of the memorandum of understanding (MoU) signed between ISEM and WMU on June 14, 2019.

This ceremony was attended by his Excellency the Ambassador of the Kingdom of Morocco to Sweden Mr. **Karim MEDREK**.

As part of his visit to WMU, the director of ISEM had a meeting with the president of WMU to discuss the cooperation actions program for the year 2023.



Mr. **BRIOUIG** also held a meeting at the headquarters of the "**Sasakawa Ocean Institute**" with Professor Ronan Long, the director of this outstanding research institute, established by **WMU** and the **Nippon Foundation-Japan**. The discussions focused on the prospects for collaboration in the field of ocean research and marine renewable energies between the Sasakawa Ocean Institute and the ISEM Oceanographic Observatory.

At the end of this meeting the director of ISEM invited Professor Ronan Long to visit ISEM to witness its research capabilities and to further discuss and agree on a joint research program for the upcoming years.
